

A DIFFICULT LIFE?

Life seems hard at times. Things don't seem to go as we want. Problems arise that become mountains looming before us. At such a time, we know God is with us to strengthen and support us. Talking to Him helps us carry our burdens. John the baptizer, from his youth, lived a hard life. When he became an adult, he went to live in the wilderness of Judaea, an inhospitable terrain inhabited by wild beasts. His clothing was made from animal skins, and his food was locusts and honey gathered in the wild (Matthew 3:4). The Word of the Lord came to him there; not telling him of a softer life ahead, but telling him of a great work that had been prophesied by Isaiah (40:3), Malachi (4:5-6) and others. The work was to be very demanding, going against the religious thinking of the day. He would have enemies and would finally be killed for his message (Matthew 14:10). Knowing how hard his life would be, he put his whole heart and strength into the task. His was a work nobody else could do. Your work and mine is a work nobody else can do - that of trying to convert our family members and friends
