In fact, the New Testament mentions NOT one direct verse informing the church on the use of instrumental music, yet the Old Testament gives intricate, full & precise details of their use in worship. Instruments were not introduced into the church until hundreds of years later as the church slid into apostasy. Why has the church struggled over such an obvious subject? Let us only be satisfied with what we can prove from scripture. God bless our purity of heart & purpose.
