There is a man named Zeke who decided he wanted to become an airplane pilot. So, he researched the internet for the most reputable flying schools. After screening out the largest and most advertised institutions, he decided to go to one named 'J Crist's School for Pilots'. After he investigated Mr. Crist's method of teaching and checking with others who became pilots via this school, he enrolled in the program. The school is tough and he struggles in the beginning ... but as time goes by he becomes more and more confident that he has picked the right program to become a proficient pilot. Then, when his solo test came, he passes with "flying colors". He credits the Crist School for Pilot's and their stringent program for his accomplishment. After Zeke has accrued many hours of flight time, however, he starts to wonder if there could be another way of flying that is not exactly like the way he learned. He hears from friends and reads books that some of the guidelines taught by the Crist School might be out-of-date and no longer necessary to get a pilot's license. But when Zeke changed to a different school of beliefs is he still a Cristian? In the realm of Jesus Christ our teacher; if one follows Him and His teachings they can call themselves Christians. If, however one is not following His teachings and commands only, is that person still able to add 'ian' to Christ?
