But really, didn't we all need someone to re-teach the Bible to us on many points? Didn't we need someone to explain to us the history behind the verses and the "rightly divided" meaning of each?

Then Philip ran up to the chariot and heard the man reading Isaiah the prophet. "Do you understand what you are reading?" Philip asked. "How can I," he said, "unless someone explains it to me?" So, he invited Philip to come up and sit with him.

Then Philip began with that very passage of Scripture and told him the good news about Jesus. As they traveled along the road, they came to some water and the eunuch said, "Look, here is water. What can stand in the way of my being baptized? And he gave orders to stop the chariot. Then both Philip and the eunuch went down into the water and Philip baptized him.
Acts 8:35-38 (NIV)

The process of leading others to Jesus is quite simple once we find a willing participant like the Ethiopian eunuch. Philip began to explain to him the prophet Isaiah's verses about Jesus that he was reading from Old Testament scripture and revealed who Jesus was and what he did for mankind. The Ethiopian heard, believed, and knew he was in need of baptism. He was baptized and went on rejoicing!
