What should Easter mean to you as a Christian?

I think most of you know that the word Easter is not a biblical term. Easter is a traditional word, that is assigned to our calendar each year; in the early Spring. There are several worldly and religious traditions associated with Easter. The Easter Bunny, Easter Baskets, Easter Eggs and Candies, are all part of the world's traditions. Some of the religious traditions include giving up things for a period of time called Lent, which ends each year on Easter. There is no Biblical authority for Lent, and this practice. Also, many traditional religions place extra significance on what is called Passion Week; which refers to the week before Easter. It starts with Palm Sunday as it's beginning, and Easter Sunday as the end.

Even though Passion Week is based somewhat on what happened to Jesus on the last week of His life, and resulted in His death and resurrection; Passion Week is still a religious tradition of men. Easter Sunday, is on a different date on the calendar each year. There is no exact date that is Christ's Resurrection Day. However, it is true that He arose from the dead on a Sunday; the first day of the week. The Bible is clear about that, in all four of the Gospels. Mt.28:1ff, Mk.16:1-6, Lk.24:1-7, Jn.20:1ff. Jesus arose from the dead on the first day of the week. Therefore, it is Christ and His victory over sin and death that we should celebrate and remember; each first day of the week as we take the Lord's Supper together. We do this in remembrance of Him and what he did to redeem us from our sins. Hopefully, this will help you understand what is based on the traditions of men; and what is true from God's word. The most important thing about Easter Sunday each year, is that it represents Christ's Resurrection Day in which He overcame sin and death on our behalf. Praise God for this victorious event!
