



### ABOUT FORGIVING

There are times when someone really hurts another with their words, actions or attitude. If you happen to be the victim, the words of Jesus in Luke 17:3-4 have a special meaning. The subject is forgiving, no matter how many times one does you wrong. This is one of the harder commands of our Lord. Nothing is easy about constantly forgiving one who continues to do you wrong. When Jesus told the apostles this was their task, they responded in verse 5, "Lord, increase our faith." This seems to be the key: to have enough faith to be able to forgive a constant offender. Another statement of Jesus must be considered in this matter. In Matthew 5:44 Jesus said, "...pray for them which despitefully use you..." We cannot and must not carry grudges against those who do us wrong. If we do, we will be lost just as surely as they.
