

Did I Fail?

Recently, there was a conversation between two Christians. One was an elderly man who was one of the greatest workers in the church. In the talk that followed, he told of those that he tried to convert, and others he had tried to restore. He concluded, "But I failed." Thinking on this, we can consider some Bible events. When Jesus was teaching, He wanted all who heard His message to turn to God. How about when He was teaching the rich, young ruler? The young man turned away sorrowfully without obeying. Had Jesus failed? Stephen (Acts 7:2-53) preached a powerful sermon to the Sanhedrin. They rejected his message and condemned him to death. Had he failed? Paul and Barnabas preached in Antioch (Acts 13) and were not able to convert any of the Jews on that occasion. Had they failed? None of these people failed. They did their best. When we do our best to convert or restore someone and are not able to do so, we can't think of it as failure. If we do, we will begin thinking of ourselves as failures. When that happens, we will be greatly hindered in our work for Christ.
