Waiting Silently on God

"Therefore, I will look to the Lord; I will wait for the God of my salvation; My God will hear me" (Micah 7:7)

Have you ever had someone ask you a question, but instead of allowing you to answer, the person kept on talking? He never stopped to listen for a response, and you wondered why you were approached at all? Sometimes we approach God in the same way. We go to God in prayer and we talk – and talk and talk and talk. In those many words, we may be revealing that we trust more in our ability to inform God than in Him, His solutions and His pace.

Twice David says that he would wait silently for God (Psalms 62:1,5). David was both a man of action and a man of words, but he realized the need to let God respond in His own time to problems David surely thought were quite urgent.

Silence doesn't necessarily mean the absence of words, but it certainly meant that David knew he didn't have the answers, nor did anyone else. All he could do was turn his life over to God and wait silently for God to intervene as He saw fit. David exhorts his own soul to trust God, fully and exclusively.
