Walk In Wisdom

"Walk in wisdom toward them that are without, redeeming the time. Be wise in the way you act toward outsiders; make the most of every opportunity. Let your conversation be always full of grace, seasoned with salt, so that you may know how to answer everyone.

(Colossians 4:5-6)

In the Bible, "walk" means our everyday way of living and our dealings with others around us. How are we to deal with life and other people, especially those who are outside of Christ? We are to "walk in wisdom" toward them. In other words, we are to treat them as our Lord would treat them, with kindness and gently try to lead them to Christ (Matt 7:12). Some will listen to the Gospel message, others will refuse it. Our part is to "plant the seed" of God's word in their hearts and lives (Luke 8:11, Mark 16:15).

Our speech should be "with grace" to them, in this context, "grace" means with kindness and understanding. We should always remember that we were once in a lost condition before God, until someone took the time and effort to teach us Christ's way to eternal life (Ephesians 2:12).

We also have a duty to speak with wisdom based upon the Lord's instructions to us in His word. That requires our taking time to study and learn the message of the Gospel (II Timothy 2:15). If we take that time and put forth the effort, we will be able to answer with His message and plant the seed of God's word in their hearts and minds.
